Please explain your role as Housing Manager:

My duties as a housing manager is to collect rent, analyze rent arrears, prepare court papers for court. I also conduct intakes and interviews for and process applications. I communicate with the maintenance staff and conduct inspections. I conduct monthly housing meetings with tenants, counsel and prepare and maintain progress notes. I prepare all monthly reports for vendors and funding sources. I supervisor two staff members and are responsible for tracking hours and time off.

How long have you been with the YWCA Yonkers and what has been your greatest accomplishment?

I've worked at the YWCA for over 20 years and have been able to assist and enhance many lives. Anytime a resident finds a job,

enrolls in school or begins to work on personal and mental health is an accomplishment. I've been married for 33 years to a great husband and have raise four amazing kids who grew up in the "Y". Maintaining my home and family while staying true to the YWCA's mission is a great accomplishment and I'm not finished yet!
